

Grateful salute to Jerry Garcia

Ten years after the death of Jerry Garcia, WBAI (99.5 FM) runs its annual salute tonight to Garcia and his most famous band, the Grateful Dead.

Actually, host **Mandrake** of WBAI's "Morning Dew" will focus mostly on Garcia and his own musical diversity. The program will include Garcia's own writings, writings about him and lots of music.

It runs 7 p.m.-midnight and it's part of WBAI's current fund drive.
